In this one-hour presentation, Joseph Meehan will present examples of how different types of fog can be exploited in landscape compositions using many examples from the Northwest Corner. Much of the material will be drawn from his latest book, "Photographing the Elements" (Focal Press) and the article, "Joseph Meehan, Fog Meister" in the new interactive tablet magazine: Photographers (<http://www.photographersi.com>).
